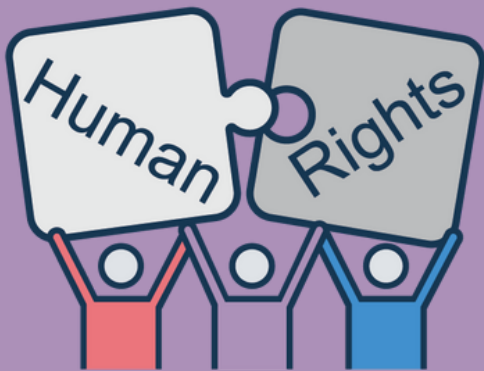


Do you want to know more about your rights?
