





The NHS locally has been chosen to be a national Test Bed site. This means GPs, hospitals, care homes and others are working together with technology companies to see how we can deliver care differently using new technologies. The local programme is called the Perfect Patient Pathway and in the first instance is supporting patients with Long Term Conditions.


## Please note:

Download the free SOS UK app onto your smartphone



Create your emergency health record, showing allergies, medications or long-term conditions



This creates a unique, printable QR code to use as your lock screen or wallpaper



Emergency responders can see your key medical information by scanning this QR code



Your emergency contacts will be notified by email exactly where you
