EMERGENCY FIRST AID AT WORK

The Emergency First Aid at Work course covers everything you need to deal with for most first aid situations including: infection control, first aid kits, how to act in an emergency, primary and secondary surveys, CPR and the recovery position, treating an unconscious casualty (including seizures), treating wounds and bleeding and shock, choking and various minor injuries. This course gives you a qualification lasting three years.

MEDICATION ADMISITRATION AND MANAGEMENT

Half day course covering: Training, competency and responsibilities, types of medication, legislation, regulations, policies & procedures, administration (dignity, covert administration, routes, PRN, self administration), management, accountability, COSHH, safe and secure storage, MAR Process, controlled drugs, effect of medication, managing errors, safe disposal.

FOOD SAFETY (LEVEL 1)

Food Safety half day course covers legislation, storage, hazards and control measures, food poisoning, cooking, key temperatures, hygiene, cleaning processes, record-keeping and due diligence.

MENTAL HEALTH INSIGHT

This lived experience delivered mental health training gives learners a basic understanding of the experience and distress of living with mental health conditions. It looks at the arguments for and against the labelling of people who are in distress and how people who support people can feel more confident in creating a safe space for people free from judgement and discrimination. The course also gives insight into working with people with suicidal ideation and gives helpful suggestions of where to access help.

INTRODUCTION TO DIGITAL SKILLS AND PROGRAMMES

These training sessions aim to give attendees a good understanding of various digital skills and programs used in many areas of work today. The course will introduce basic concepts and teach attendees how to perform some of the most common tasks.
