## **ACCREDITATION PROCESS**

Accreditation is a simple but robust process whereby providers complete a self-assessment form and provide supporting evidence to a central team for verification. Evidence will be in scale to the type of goods and services being provided so that providers of all sizes will be on an equal footing.

Become accredited and have use of the CredAbility logo, receive a copy of the Charter, take part in the Providers Hub, have your services promoted directly to disabled people and, most importantly, become part of a growing movement, which takes pride in its commitment to disabled customers.

## COSTS

One of the things we realised by working closely with both providers and disabled people is that we did not want prohibitive cost to be a barrier to participation in the scheme. Therefore we have come up with a pricing structure, which we believe is affordable for even the smallest of providers.
