Sheffield Adult Care In Crisis 2016

In July 2015 a number of Sheffield residents who access Adult Social Care, their families and carers/allies came together in a safe environment to discuss the difficulties they faced, their fears that the system was in crisis and their concerns for the future.

Their experiences and personal stories were shared, and subsequently, a report was published.

This year we will come together again to see what, if anything has changed; to provide a forum in order to encourage further discussion and give people an opportunity to raise concerns and share their fears on issues such as the planned review, service cuts, commissioning changes, the merging of Social/NHS care, etc.
